“Youhavgotmyword.com” a website where user can create new word, new slogan which is not exists in English dictionary.

The Client proposed to develop a clever, witty, website that is professional but with an edge to it. In other words, it should be lighthearted and fun yet interesting enough so users will want to come back and submit more words and slogans. The site need to be to be colorful, fun, and interesting with maybe 3 primary colors, with a lot of white space – not overly crowded.

The Client was looking for something original and somewhat creative.

## Project Detail

**Registration** for new words and, or slogans by the users.

1. Collection subscriber information: name, address, phone, email etc.
2. Assigning a unique number to the user. (When the user submits a word, a 'W' will be appeared in front of their number, if they submit a catch phrase; 'CP' will be appeared in front of it.)
3. Issuing a digital certificate that looks like a paper certificate and sending it to them via email after the Registration process.
4. Registration should pay through iPortis.

## **Submission** of new words and slogans

Following information will display at the home page

1. The number of members on the site.
2. The number of words submitted to date
3. The number of slogans submitted to date
4. The number of words/slogans submitted this week, month, and year.
5. The numbers of words submitted by each of the United States. For example, the statistical page should show that California submitted 10 words this month; New York submitted 15, etc.

## **Voting**

For example, if the word of the day is “varlet.” Client want to poll users and ask them if they think this word is:

- A Clever Word
- An Innovative Word
- A word worth using
- A bad word

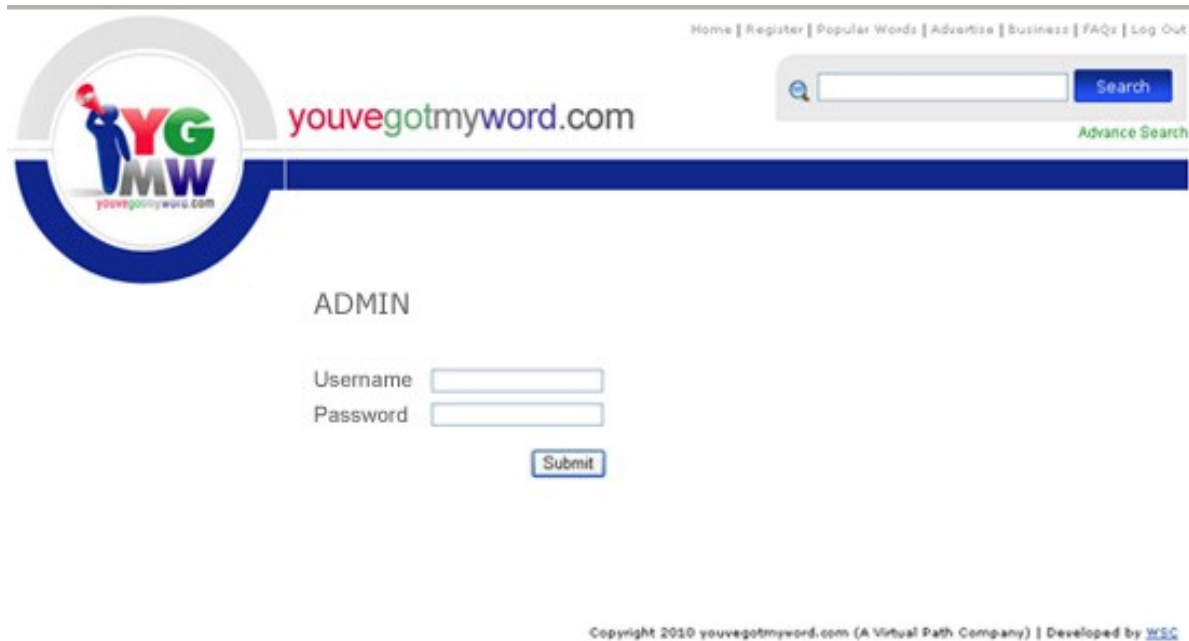
**Showcasing the 50 most popular words** somewhere on the site. It could be something like a Word Gallery, or Word Carousel, or some other clever way of showcasing some of the words that people submit to the site. Visitors of the site could click on a word or slogan and see the definition, and if possible, how many times it was found in use on the Internet.

Random “word-of-the-day” to pop up at the top of the front page somewhere that should not be repeated within 365 days.

## **Admin**

1. Administrator will be able to send out email to all registered users so he/she can send an announcement or update for those users who provide permission.
2. Administrator will be able to sort and find all users in the database.
3. Administrator will be able to search by state the number of submissions.

4. The ability to sort by number of votes.
5. Ability to set up iPortis link.
